The Preposition Slides were created by . . .

The *Preposition slides* (Set 1) were created by a variety of methods. The ice cubes were drawn by hand using Sketchbook© Pro version 1.3.1 by Autodesk© on an iPad. The ice cube graphic was then turned into a jpeg and imported into Microsoft publisher. The tumbler used to illustrate the function of prepositions is a public domain image created using Inkscape SVG, and this was also imported into MS Publishers version 2003.¹ Once in publisher these images were combined by myself and placed into various configurations to reach their intended effect.

The shepherd and the sheep were hand sketched using pencil, and then colored with colored pencils. These images were scanned and digitized and imported into MS Publisher to be labeled with corresponding Hebrew prepositions.
